

MAIL FRAUD ALERT

Beware of current Mail Fraud/Fraudulent Cheque Scam under the guise of "Amica Market Research" and "Amica Grant Co."

Amica Mature Lifestyles wants you to be aware of current scams taking place, using the Amica name and fraudulent cheques in order to add credibility to their offers.

These scams in no way represent Amica or any programs connected with Amica Mature Lifestyles.

If you receive a promise of money in the mail from "The Amica Grant Company" (entitling you to a Debt Relief Grant) or from "Amica Market Research" (advising you that you have been selected to be a "Mystery Shopper"), Please contact your local authorities immediately. These offers are fraudulent and criminal.

Amica is not the only target of these scammers, other companies and financial institutions around the world have been targeted as well, using other company names in place of ours. The scam is directed to all age groups, not just seniors.

Therefore we caution you that if you received a similar letter or grant in the mail, do not proceed with any direction you are given by the sender until you check the authenticity of the claim and direction.

In general when it comes to scams of this type, they are sophisticated, look legitimate and legal, all of which adds to their ability to prey on unsuspecting victims. **However, it takes very little time to ensure letters similar to the offers above are legitimate or not. For your own safety, please first check with a trusted and known family member or advisor.**

Please pass this information along to anyone you can, in order to protect yourself, friends and family from being a victim.

What to do if you receive a letter in the mail similar to the above "offers":

If you receive a letter from any institution asking you to send money, cash a cheque or are offered monetary rewards "out of the blue", **Do Not Respond, Do Not Cash the Cheque (sic) and do not Send Money.** Never send money to anyone unless you first contact a known family member to determine if the request is a legitimate one.
